Variety:	Blend of Riesling, Müller-Thurgau, Silvaner and Kerner.
Origin:	Nahe Liebfraumilch is a traditional cuvee of Riesling, Müller-Thurgau, Silvaner and Kerner grapes sourced from the Nahe region. It is the most popular German wine in the world and reflects perfectly all the charm and character of Germany's wines.
Vintage Note:	A mild winter and warm spring followed by a hot summer with moderate rainfall led to overall healthy grapes with pleasant sugar levels. Vintage 2015 delivers very fruit driven, elegant, lively, bright and durable wines.
Winemaking:	This Qualitätswein from the Nahe region was fermented temperature controlled, stored in stainless steel and bottled cold sterile.
Wine Analysis:	Alc. 8.5 % vol. Residual Sugar 38.0 g/l Acidity 7.2 g/l
Winemakers Tasting Note:	This wine shows a fine and fragrant bouquet. Its taste is soft and light with good fruit aromas and a slightly sweet finish.
