A beautiful Sancerre. The perfect wine for a sunny spring afternoon

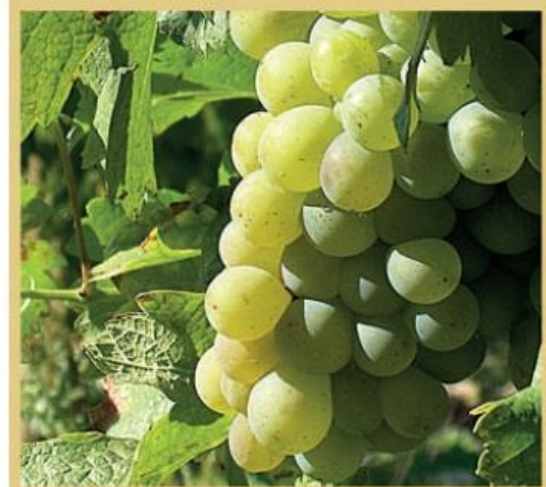

This classic Sancerre reflects the chalk and limestone soils known as 'caillottes' for which the village of Chavignol is rightly famed. It's a riveting Gold medal winner that comes courtesy of Serge and Elisabeth Laporte, whose 10 hectare domaine has been in the family for generations. And it looks set to remain so for at least one more, as they have now been joined by their son Guillaume.



He spent three years studying oenology at the university in Tours, and his input has brought a further dimension of quality to an already excellent cuvée. Premium Sauvignon, the 2015 has incredible mineral richness and pristine flavours. Earlier vintages have also won over the toughest wine judges. Excellent with warm goat's cheese salad or seafood.
