Subzone: Val do Salnés.

Made with grapes from our youngest vinevards.

The vineyards are grown on sandy loam soils, granite and slightly acidic.

Fermented in stainless steel tanks between 16 and 18 °C for 21 days.

Vintage 2014.

Serving temperature: 8 - 10 °C.







Straw yellow with green trim and intense. Clean and bright.

Medium-high intensity highlights green apple and lemon peel. Hints of stone fruit (white plum).

The palate is fresh, where repeated citrus and is a reminder of herbs. Elegant bitter finish.
