TASTING NOTE

A rich blend of old Oloroso and sweet Pedro Ximenez matured in the solera system for many years to create a rich sweet wine with full nutty and dried fruit aromas.

Color: Very Dark Amber.

Aroma: Sweet and delicate, this cream Sherry has distinct Pedro Ximenez character on the bouquet and taste. Notes crème brulee and raisins abound in a lush, velvet-textured wine best served after dinner.

Flavor: Sweet, rich, warm, smooth.

Serving suggestions: Ideal as an aperitif or as an accompaniment of desserts and cheeses or alternatively as a long drink on the rocks with a slice of orange.
